AMSP offer a range of professional development and student enrichment opportunities to promote the study of Post-16 Maths Courses.

These include a mix of face-to-face, live online, on demand and sustained professional development courses as well as a wide variety of student enrichment events.

The University of Liverpool Maths School offer a range of *outreach opportunities* for both students and teachers.

At KS5, specifically, there is an Aspiring Mathematician's Programme for students who are going on to study Mathematics at university, with a strong focus on entrance exam preparation.

Also, there are lots of online opportunities for students at KS4, including content delivery of Further Maths, advanced problem solving and support with GCSE Maths.
